Sadly, it has been a "war zone" in the past few months. The last 5 months have seen more than 500 people die for the drug war alone. Most of it in the northern state of Chihuahua, where we have been working for the last 5 years.

Three weeks ago I went to preach in a church in the border city of Juarez (right next to El Paso, TX). We were in the middle of the most dangerous area where over 500 women have been killed according

By God's grace we are trying to do what we can. Because of these great needs and tragedies we often wrestle with discouragement and a strong feeling of impotence. But scripture reminds us that God is faithful and through His Word he restores our faith and strength. Amen. He still loves sinners.

Your prayers and help are a wonderful strength for us and we thank you very much for lifting us in prayer and support. We just finished a campaign in Colonia Zapata where God saved many. We have just begun a new campaign in the town called Anahuac. Pray with us that God will do the same work in Anahuac as He did in Colonia Zapata.

Thank God for the prayers of the Saints. Wendy is doing much better. She cannot have surgery until her blood reachess normal levels. A Christian doctor told her to bide her time and not rush to surgery because it may not be necessary, Lord willing.

Here is good news: Jesus is coming back soon. Yes, He is.
